What does my child need to bring to class?

Water, parent, and a ready to have fun attitude.

What should my child wear?

Tennis shoes must be worn and loose-fitting playwear and/or baseball pants are recommended.

Are there breaks during the class?

Yes, short breaks are given when needed to give the participants a chance to get a drink and help them regain focus.

Isn't this kind of a young age for my child to be introduced to baseball?

No, MVP Lil' Sluggers program stresses fun, participation, safety and socialization ahead of everything. We do not stress or promote any kind of competitive environment. Our mission is to give grade-school aged children a basic exposure to baseball skills in a very fun environment. Everything that is done is based around the children having fun.
